

MINUTES-REGULAR
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING – May 10, 2017 – 6:00 p.m.

PUBLIC PRESENT: Jake Bethel (Perry County News), Deputy Hendershot (Perry County Sheriff's Department)

COUNCIL & EMPLOYEES PRESENT: Jane Efinger-Hayden, Sharman Jarboe, Brandon Kleeman, Linda Crawford and Nathan Gehlhausen

ABSENT: Pudder Linne, Jay Oliva, and Adam Hoffman

The public was asked to sign in and get an agenda which advised the meeting was being recorded.

The meeting began with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Time sheets were previously signed by Linda and returned to Jane.

Linda Crawford, President, called the regular meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

Agendas, mail, correspondence, financials and minutes were distributed.

A motion was made by Sharman to accept the Consent Agenda, which included the previous month's minutes, current agenda and current financials. Brandon seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

INVITED REPRESENTATIVES: Note, Pudder was gone to an IMPA meeting. Jane spoke with him earlier, there were no fire runs this month. We did take delivery of the new Ford truck today. Jane added to insurance and received ID card.

LINDA: the IMPA Rider will be tabled, due to having some questions. ***A list of town issues has been compiled. We will draft a letter to go out to all citizens. Ordinances will be referenced. The attorney will be contacted for advice as well. If this does not address the issues, another specific letter will be sent to the individuals. ***Advised she was told that the DOT would, for free, put up a digital "speed" sign. Jane advised she will call them tomorrow. The speed zone "35 mph" have been posted, but not being adhered to. ***Jane advised Linda that all the Abatement letters (5) have been received. It is now up to them to comply by filing with the courthouse. ***Advised we are waiting on a report from the DNR meeting that was held on 5/2/17. ***We typed up and gave a copy of seven previous vandalism reports to Deputy Hendershot that had not been addressed.

SHARMAN: Advised Terry Weyer inquired about getting new directional signs for the Christ of the Ohio-three. May call Region 15 for further assistance on this. ***Advised she has personally ordered a new 3x5 flag for the Riverfront Park flagpole. Hopefully it will be in before Memorial Day.

BRANDON: Advised he and his company will be doing some work down on the end of the drop-off at the boat ramp. Will be checking with DNR and using their own insurance. Will be putting some stone there, as there is a break going into the river creating a bad drop-off. ***Will table ATV for now.



JAY: Absent.



He will look into this. Visor lights are also an option. ***Advised Steve Hauser (EMA director) said they may have an extra 800-band radio we can have soon. Will have to have it installed as it is not a hand-held. Will need to be programmed for Perry County. He will look into this also as Greg Linne from Tell City can install these items.






