Utilities-Pudder Linne, Town Manager:

- Update on Solar field – All information has been given to Perry County Economic Division that manages the property. They will determine price for acreage and send a price.
- Electric – The contract we received for electrical support from Tell City has been reviewed by our Attorney, Chris Goffinet. We have signed it. We now have their charges for support, jobs and man hours. So that is completed.
- Water – None
- Sewer – We updated lift station at Consolidated. Would have cost more to repair than purchase a new one. It was costly, around \$8k.
- New hire – Roger and I met and interviewed Devin Meunier. We are checking his references- If they check out, we will offer him job as Utility Worker. He will apprentice water and electric. We will give him raise after 90 days if we feel he is meeting expectations for employment. Bret Kleeman asked if he would be working both water and electric. Pudder Linne said yes, he would. Pudder stated-We will eventually need to hire second employee.




