ORDINANCE NO. 2 – 1 – 18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING



THE SCHEDULE OF WATER RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AND SERVICE BY TROY MUNICIPAL WATER WORKS

PHASE I ONLY

WHEREAS, the Town of Troy owns and operates a municipal water works for the purposes of providing water services to customers in and around the town of Troy; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Troy's existing schedule of rates and charges established by Ordinance are insufficient to produce sufficient revenue to pay and provide for the expenses of operation and maintenance and to provide funds for necessary replacement and improvements to the water system in accordance with law, such that it is necessary to establish a new schedule of rates and charges to produce sufficient revenue for these purposes; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Troy has commissioned and reviewed a rate study to increase rates consistent with the above and has provided the public an opportunity to appear and comment upon the proposed new rates in a public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Troy as follows:

SECTION ONE. The schedule of rates and charges for water usage attached hereto as Exhibit "A" shall be applied for the use of and the services rendered by the water works system of the Town of Troy.

SECTION TWO. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after is passage and publication.

(A) METERED RATES PER MONTH

(D) TAP CHARGE

See below

Each user at the time that is connected with the waterworks system shall pay a charge to cover the costs of excavating and tapping the main; furnishing and installing service pipe from the main to the lot line; furnishing and installing corporation and stop cocks; and furnishing and installing meter crocks (if outside), yoke, and meter. The charge for a 5/8 or 3/4 inch meter tap shall be \$1,000.00. The charge for a tap larger than 3/4 inch meter tap shall be the cost of labor, materials, power machinery, transportation, and overhead incurred for installing the tap, but shall not be less than the charge for a 3/4 inch meter tap.

(E) RECONNECTION CHARGE

\$ 50.00

When the service is turned off for non-payment of bill, or whenever for any reason beyond the control of the waterworks, a re-establishment of service is required by any one customer, this charge will be made by the waterworks to cover the cost of discontinuance and re-establishment of service. The charge, together with any arrears due to the waterworks, shall be paid by the customer before service will be re-established.

(F) LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

All bills for water service not paid within ten (10) days from the date thereof, as stated in such bills, shall be subject to a late charge of ten (10) percent of the first three (3) dollars and three (3) percent of the excess over three (3) dollars.

(G) TEMPORARY USERS

Water furnished to temporary users, such as contractors, circuses, etc. shall be charged on the basis of the above metered rates for usage as estimated by the waterworks superintendent.

(H) BAD CHECK CHARGE

A charge of \$25.00 will be made to any customer who pays his bill by check which is returned to the utility because of insufficient funds.

(I) METER TAMPERING CHARGE

Any customer who tampers with his metering services shall be charged for any damage to the equipment or installation. The charge shall include the cost of replacement or repairs to the equipment or installation, and the time involved for labor and utility equipment.
