

ORDINANCE AMENDMENT NO.: 4-1-16 FOR ORIGINAL ORDINANCE 11-2013-4  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PRIOR ESTABLISHMENT OF STORMWATER RATES FOR THE TOWN OF TROY, INDIANA

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Troy, Indiana ("Town") owns and operates a Stormwater system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Troy Town Council has established a Department of Stormwater Management in accordance with the provisions of I.C.8-1.5-3-3 et seq. ("Act"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Stormwater Management is being managed by the Troy Town Council of the Town of Troy and will be responsible for establishing, reviewing and recommending rates for these services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that in order to properly manage the Stormwater system that provisions must be made to study, design and implement a system for the safe and efficient disposition of Stormwater and that funds be made available for such purpose;

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds, based upon the advice of its counsel, that the provisions of the Act apply to collection, disposal and drainage of storm and surface water, that the Town may finance its Stormwater System pursuant to the Act; and that the provisions of the Act will enable the Town to finance and operate and control its Stormwater System:


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Troy, Indiana:

Section 1. Stormwater Fees will be charged based per water meter to those within the Town limits including the Annexation area.
